WEBMASTER

- 1) Responsible for construction, organization, and presentation of the Area website.
- 2) Responsible for maintaining reasonable security of site and anonymity of the Area's
- 3) Works with Area Committee Members assisting them with their IT needs (in relation to the website).
- 4) Backs up the website's data files on a regular basis.
- 5) Maintains contact with the Website Hosting Service.
- 6) Manages the Area "announce" mailing list and Area committee email "alias" list.
- 7) Helps districts develop their own websites.
